

## Faculty Reading Group at STCC to Present Selections From Literature

The Faculty Reading Group at Springfield Technical Community College will present its semi-annual performance of literary readings on the morning of Monday, November 2. Each semester several members of the faculty and staff choose favorite passages from plays, poems, novels and other literary works, and perform dramatic readings for the benefit of college students and the general public, bringing these passages to life. The performances will be held at 9:05, 10:00, and again at 11:15 a.m. on November 2 in the Scibelli Hall Theater at STCC, and are offered free of charge.

Professor Dennison Rice, founding director of the college's drama society, will again direct the STCC Faculty Reading Group. Each semester the group selects a theme around which literary selections are chosen, using works ranging from those of literary giants to lesser-known avant-garde artists, and occasionally selections from their own writings. This semester the theme is Obsessions and Compulsions.

This presentation is part of STCC's annual cultural and educational special events series. Since 1995, the Ovations series has brought locally- and nationally-acclaimed writers, artists, musicians, dancers, theater groups, historians, and experts in the fields of science and health to the college, for the benefit of the college community and the community at large. The events are open to the public free of charge.
