

Drama Society at STCC to Present Edward Albee Plays

The American Dream and *Zoo Story*, two classic one-act plays by American playwright Edward Albee, will be the fall production of the Gallery Players drama society at Springfield Technical Community College, on December 3-6. The actors are students in the theater classes at STCC, under the direction of Professor Dennison Rice.

Rice said, "These plays are classic, because they were among the first examples of a new genre – Theater of the Absurd. The solid critical reception and commercial success of these plays demonstrated both relevance and resonance with their audiences and society." He added, "The Gallery Players continue to choose classic and memorable plays which represent theater's undeniable role in our culture. All cultures create a forum in which to confront change, and all cultures have used theater for this purpose."

The plays will be performed in the theater of Scibelli Hall on the STCC campus on Thursday through Saturday, December 3-5, at 7:30 p.m., with a matinee performance on Sunday, December 6 at 2:00 p.m. Tickets are \$10 for general admission and \$6 for students, and may be purchased at the door.
