

United States Navy Band to perform Country/Bluegrass Music
September 20
at Springfield Technical Community College, Springfield Armory National Historic Site

The U.S. Navy Band “Country Current” will present a free concert on Sunday, September 20 on the Springfield Armory National Historic Site, which includes the campus of Springfield Technical Community College. The country/bluegrass concert will be held from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., on the campus green. There is plenty of free parking.



Country Current tours the United States annually from their base in Washington DC. They have entertained at the White House, and performed at the Grand Ole Opry, Nashville Now! and the Wheeling Jamboree. The seven-member group performs all types of country music, from contemporary country rock to traditional bluegrass, and western swing.

The concert will be broadcast live on the STCC radio station, WTCC, at 90.7 FM. Broadcasting at 4,000 watts, WTCC can be heard throughout much of western Mass. and into Connecticut. WTCC program host Dave Helman, who offers the Country Corner radio program each Saturday afternoon from 1:00 to 3:00, will assist in the concert broadcast.
