

Placement in Employment, 2014 Graduates

The information provided here was compiled from the Springfield Technical Community College Graduate Placement Survey. Its purpose is to gather information on the graduates' educational and employment activities in the 9-12 month period after their graduation from STCC. The survey is administered each spring on the previous academic year's graduating class, with a follow-up mailing to non-respondents approximately 5-6 months later. The responses to the survey are used in part for the completion of the Career and Technical Education data report as required by the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006.

Overall, **92%** of Job-seeking respondents in the **2014** graduating class were employed at the time of the survey, and **70%** were employed in a field related to their program of study. The placement information for individual programs is below. Due to privacy regulations, information for programs with group sizes of less than 10 is not shown.
