Placement in Employment, 2022 Graduates

The information provided here was compiled from the Springfield Technical Community College Graduate Placement Survey. Its purpose is to gather information on the graduates' educational and employment activities in the 9-12 month period after their graduation from STCC. The survey is administered each spring to the previous academic year's graduating class, with a follow-up mailing to non-respondents approximately 5-6 months later. The responses to the survey are used in part for the completion of the Career and Technical Education data report as required by the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006.

Overall, 78% of job-seeking respondents in the 2022 graduating class were employed at the time of the survey, and 56% were employed in a field related to their program of study. The placement information for all individual programs was below 10. Due to privacy regulations, information for individual programs is not shown. Instead employment outcomes are presented by each school division.
