Professional Brewing
Certificate: Saturdays, June

ServSafe Preparation: Saturdays, June 2, July 7, July 21, Aug. 4 and Aug. 18, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. This course, which includes six hours of classroom instruction and a two-hour exam, is designed to help restaurant professionals obtain their ServSafe Certificate to ensure their workplace meets industry standards for cleanliness along with proper safety requirements for food handling and preparation.

Certified Nurse Aide (CNA)
Plus Program CNA/CPR/
HHA & Alzheimer's: Monday-Thursdays, June 4-July
26. This 184-hour course
offers training to become a
certified nurse aide as well
as home health aide training.
Students who successfully
complete this program will
receive certification in CPR
and learn about Alzheimer's
or related neurological disorders.
