Job Description

- ◆ Maintain an Open House atmosphere in the Student Ambassador Center during the first two weeks of each semester to answer questions students may have about STCC;
- ◆ Maintain 4 office hours a week in the Ambassador Center;
- ◆ Design, create, and implement 1 Student Ambassador Event per year (either one community service event or one that fulfills a student need);
- ◆ Complete an assigned amount of hours of community service per semester;
- ◆ Participate in Student Activities Events in addition to other College Wide Events;
- ◆ Participate Student Activities Information Tables for at least 1 hour each per semester;
- ◆ Attend all scheduled meetings (to include bi-weekly, teambuilding and emergency meetings);
- ◆ Represent the STCC student community at a variety of events offered by STCC;
- ◆ Assist new students in becoming oriented and engaged at STCC by encouraging students to get involved in student organizations, attend campus events, and to make meaningful connections with people in the college community and promote overall student success;
- ◆ Promote STCC offices, services, activities, and events as well as hand out flyers for events;
- ◆ Assist in Orientation for Fall & Spring;
- ◆ Other events/ tasks as assigned by S.A.P. Advisor.

Requirements:

- ◆ At time of application, student must have completed 12 credits at STCC with a minimum GPA of 2.8.
- ◆ Three references attesting to your potential to serve as a Student Ambassador. At least one reference from a STCC staff or faculty member and none from family members or relatives.
- ◆ Involvement in student clubs/ organizations, or community service work is highly desired.
- ◆ Must sign a “Student Ambassador Agreement” which will outline expectations of responsibilities.
- ◆ Agree to mandatory attendance at annual summer training session.

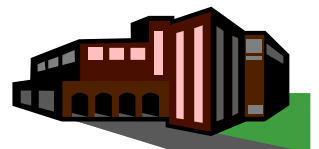
Application Process
