Springfield Technical Community College's Associate in Arts in Liberal Arts/General Studies, with an option in Applied Psychology

to

Bay Path University's Bachelor of Arts in Psychology, with concentrations in General Psychology (two divisions), Child Psychology (two divisions), Forensic Psychology (two divisions), Counseling Foundations (online), Foundations in Alcohol and Drug Abuse Counseling (online), and Human Services and Rehabilitation (online)

Statement of Purpose

Bay Path University (BPU) and Springfield Technical Community College (STCC) recognize that, for many students, the path to a bachelor's degree may begin at a community college. Moreover, for STCC's female students, diverse educational opportunities, including the advantages of enrolling in a women's university to earn a bachelor's degree, adds great value to educational experiences. This agreement acknowledges that significance and is formed to enable the smooth transfer of Springfield Technical Community College graduates to Bay Path University.

Further, the purpose of this agreement is to provide smooth transition between the two academic programs by:

- identifying all required and equivalent courses for the relevant programs at each institution, and
- facilitating credit transfer and guarantee of admission for students who meet the agreed upon criteria.

Participants

This agreement has been entered into by Springfield Technical Community College, Springfield, MA, and Bay Path University for programs offered through the traditional undergraduate program and The American Women's College, which offers degrees of study both online and at its campus located in Longmeadow, MA. Not all undergraduate programs at Bay Path University are fully offered in both modalities, but the University's structure and advising practices allow for fluid registration in both undergraduate divisions. Degree programs that are offered in both modalities and divisions are identical in terms of course requirements.

Programs/Courses Included in This Agreement

- A) Springfield Technical Community College's Degree will be accepted toward Bay Path University's Degrees.
- B) This acceptance will be offered to STCC students who enroll at Bay Path University in either the traditional undergraduate program or at The American Women's College.
- C) Coursework and credits from STCC's Degree that will be accepted and applied towards required coursework and electives for the BPU Degree at BPU will be outlined on the advising guide included in Appendix A.

Terms and Conditions of Transfer

- A) Students who graduate from the STCC's Degree with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher will be guaranteed admission into the BPU Degree under the terms of this agreement.
- B) Students applying to the traditional undergraduate program must complete the transfer application. Students applying to The American Women's College (TAWC) must complete the TAWC application. For students applying to the traditional undergraduate program, the application fee will be waived. There is no application fee for The American Women's

College.

- C) Students must submit official transcript(s) from STCC, along with all other previously attended institutions, to their admissions counselor at Bay Path University.
- D) All coursework from the sending program must be completed with grades of "C-" or better in order to be eligible for transfer.
- E) STCC students who have taken courses beyond the requirements of their STCC's Degree may request an evaluation of additional earned credits for eligibility and acceptance into the BPU Degree degree program. However, all students must complete 30 credits at Bay Path University to satisfy residency requirements.

Communications and Advising

Communication and advising is central to effective transfer/articulation. Recognizing this:

- A) The college and university agree to include information about this articulation agreement in relevant publications for the purposes of promotion and advising.
- B) The college and university agree to jointly develop appropriate transfer guides and make these available to students and advisors as appropriate.
- C) As this agreement was developed during the 2023-2024 BPU academic year, there is a possibility of curricular changes. BPU and STCC agree to notify each other promptly, in writing, of these changes in curricula that might affect the Agreement.
- D) For students applying to the traditional undergraduate program, advanced registration will take place in the spring or summer for the fall semester. For students applying to TAWC, students can register during any of six entry points throughout the academic year.
- E) The Traditional program at BPU runs two 14-week semesters beginning in September and January each year. Depending on the program, some courses run in-person, hybrid and/or online. The American Women's College runs six 6-week online sessions, the first of which starts in mid-July and concludes prior to September annually, and the sixth of which starts in early May and concludes in mid-June annually. The other four sessions align fully with the Traditional program's calendar, and financial aid eligibility requirements allow students to cross-register in the two divisions, regardless of which division is considered their division of record.
- F) Springfield Technical Community College agrees to properly advertise and provide information regarding Bay Path University, its academic programs and requirements, and services extended to transfer graduates under the terms of this agreement.
- G) Springfield Technical Community College agrees to refer students interested in a face-to-face traditional learning format to the BPU Director of Traditional Admissions (Katie Keith-Hunter, <u>kkeithhunter@baypath.edu</u>) and students interested in online accelerated asynchronous learning to the BPU Director of Enrollment Services - TAWC (Kasi Brown, <u>kasbrown@baypath.edu</u>).
- H) In accordance with BPU policy, students participating in this agreement may be able to apply up to two graduate courses from BPU toward their BPU Degree. In some cases, students must apply and be accepted into a graduate program to be eligible to do so. In the case of students in undergraduate psychology degree programs at BPU, there is no requirement to be accepted into a graduate psychology program before registering for

the two allowed graduate-level courses. Students should consult with their advisor if they have further questions or concerns. For a comprehensive listing of all graduate programs at Bay Path University, please visit https://www.baypath.edu/academics/graduate-programs/.

Implementation and Length of Agreement

- A) Bay Path University and Springfield Technical Community College agree that this Agreement becomes effective on May 1, 2023 and is applicable to eligible students in the next semester of enrollment.
- B) This agreement will remain in effect for three years from the date above unless terminated or amended by a signing representative below, from either institution, with prior written notice.
- C) This agreement does not preclude either college from entering into similar agreements with other institutions of higher education.
- D) This agreement may be amended by addendum as necessary. This means that as requirements and courses change over time this agreement may stay in force as long as the program managers, their academic supervisors, and the transfer counselors agree in writing to the change.

Signatures of Institutional Leaders and Representatives

The relevant program coordinator and/or academic department chair of each institution will be responsible for implementing this agreement, for identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, and for conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
